If you have any questions or would like tell me your donations now or would like to sign up to help, give me a call or email me. Thank you.

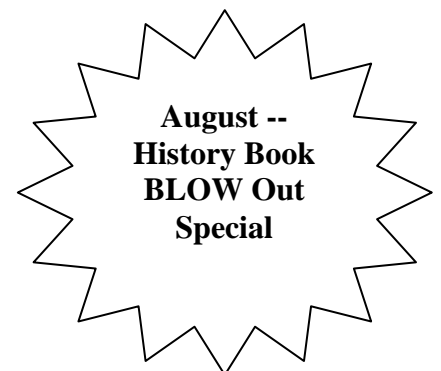

When we were active Jaycees, (Junior Chamber International) we received the honor of becoming JCI Senators. This is the highest honor bestowed upon our members world-wide. We are all members of the US JCI Senate, and our region includes the states of Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. This September, our region will be hosting JCI Senators from across the nation and also JCI Senators from Canada and some of the European countries for the US JCI Senate Fall Board of Directors meeting. On September 23<sup>rd</sup>, we are anticipating approximately 300 JCI Senators and guests spending the weekend with us in Bloomington, MN at the Holiday Inn & Suites.
